A meeting was held on March 4th, 2026 at 10:00a at the Danbury Conference Room.

Langer moved to approve the February minutes with a correction from 'February to January' regarding the approval of the minutes. Davis seconded. Motion approved.

The JWQC financial report was \$36,585.15 for JWQC balance. A motion was made by Davis to approve the financial report. Tomaszewski seconded. Motion approved. Coveau coordinated with St. Croix Finance, Larry Fisk to ensure funds will be sufficient to meet the need later this summer. Slayton will arrange a meeting with St. Croix Finance and Coveau later this month to discuss.

Brent Pardun called Coveau and would like to put an outhouse at the softball field. Edwards stated that it is outside the wellhead protection area. Coveau drafted a letter of approval for the construction of the outhouse if it is put in the previous location on 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. The commission will need more information on the location before a final decision can be made.

The Town of Swiss is doing an overlay of the district, and they would like to put in smaller lot sizes. Those who plan on doing construction will be responsible for the cost of their own hookup to the main lines.

Operator's update: Edwards stated that the samples are all good . Lead and Copper letters went to the commission members. Edwards needs 5 sample sites. The letter has a few questions that need to be answered, and she will forward those answers to the WDNR. Reed bed waste disposal will most likely take place in August. Hydro Corps inspects the cross connections. A motion was made to accept that agreement by Davis. Tomaszewski seconded. Motion approved.

No Tribal Council or finance update.

A motion by Davis, and seconded by Williamson, to adjourn the meeting at 10:31a. Motion carried.
