A meeting was held on October 14th, 2025 at 10:00a at the Danbury Convention Room.

Davis moved to approve the September minutes with a correction on the date for the financial update, change from July to August. Williamson seconded. Motion approved.

The JWQC has a balance of \$28,610.25 as of September 30, 2025. Williamson made a motion to accept the financial report. Staples seconded. Motion approved.

The tax roll will be sent 10/15/25, there are 11 to report. The accounting firm is helping Coveau with this. They have also emailed the town accountant to try and help with record keeping of ownership. The firm has also suggested that we hire an attorney.

Coveau asked the question as to whether businesses would receive the summer sewer credit? Businesses do not have the same type of usage that is stated for the residential sewer credit. Slayton made a motion to amend resolution 2012-1 to state that the sewer credit is for residential use only. Davis seconded. Motion approved. Slayton will look into whether there are any St. Croix residents that would qualify for the credit.

Edwards reported that all water valves were exercised. There is a vac truck coming within the month that might be able to suck out the sand that was found in lift nine. Edwards stated that this should be done next year. 7662 Main Street, the water was supposed to be shut off last winter and Edwards could not get it turned off. The shut off valve will need to be dug up. Edwards will contact Peterson for the repair. The commission approved for Edwards to move forward with having the repair completed. All samples for September were good.

Edwards ordered the AC unit for the plant that was previously approved. There was some major work done at the well house generator last week, Allied Generators. There was a water pump leaking and they are confident in the repair they made.

No Tribal Council or finance update.

The next meeting will be Monday, November 10th, 2025, at 10a.

A motion by Williamson, and seconded by Davis, to adjourn the meeting at 10:19a. Motion carried.
